

Where can I download Witherby Seamanship eBooks?

You can download the eBooks from the Witherbys Website: witherbys.com

Do I need a special computer to read a Witherbys eBook?

No. The Witherbys eBook Reader has been designed to work on any Windows PC, laptop or tablet PC. Mac users need to use a Windows emulator (Boot Camp or Parallels Desktop for instance).

Is it easy to download an eBook?

It is as easy as 1,2,3!

1. Select and download an eBook from the Witherby Seamanship website.
2. Import the eBook you have downloaded into the eBook reader you have installed via the Witherby Seamanship website.
3. View your eBook!

Are the eBooks compatible with other eBook Readers such as Kindle, Sony and iPad?

We are closely following the market. Although the current readers are currently attractive for novels, we feel they are not currently suitable for viewing big illustrations or technical drawings. The difference is that our eBook Reader is free, works on any Windows PC and if your machine crashes or is upgraded, you can restore everything on a new computer.

How do I unlock an eBook?

When you go to use the eBook for the first time, you will be asked to enter a code – if you are online, you will be able to obtain this code in seconds. Alternatively, you can e-mail, phone or fax us for the code.

Can I print from the eBook?

The eBook is designed to be used on screen providing a single point of access to a vast amount of reference material that can easily be accessed and searched. You can print or copy/paste extracts of the documents (approx. one chapter at a time).

Can I search the eBook?

The eBook reader has a powerful search facility which allows you to search one book – or the entire library.

Which titles are available as eBooks?

The number of eBooks available is always rising. You can view a current list at <http://www.witherbyseamanship.com>

Are there any free eBooks?

Yes. There are over 30 free eBooks available at <http://www.witherbyseamanship.com/free-ebooks-downloads.html>

Are the eBooks the same as a physical book?

Yes, the eBooks are exactly the same as the physical books. In some cases there is added material within the eBook.

Do I need to be connected to the Internet to read the eBook?

No. The eBook Reader runs without any need to access the Internet.

Can I install the eBook Reader on my company network?

Yes. This will be possible from Summer 2011.

What happens if I change my PC or if my PC crashes?

Each purchase of an eBook can automatically generate a code twice – one for the initial installation and a second should you change your PC or if your PC crashes. If you require further technical assistance you can contact our IT department who will be able to generate unlock codes manually.

I am a subscriber to *Seamanship Library*. Can my eBooks be used in conjunction with the Library?

Yes, Any eBooks added will be seamlessly integrated with Seamanship the Library, although it should be noted that they are 'one-off' purchases and are not part of the Library subscription.

This means that the eBooks will continue to be accessible even if the Seamanship Library subscription expires. They will not be automatically updated in the event of a new edition, unlike the contents of the library itself.

If you are currently using our eBook Reader, the new Seamanship Library+ will automatically find all the eBooks already installed on your machine.

Can I keep two different editions of a publication on my eBook Reader?

Yes, this is possible. Surveyors who need to access older versions of documents can install a new edition and just not remove the previous one.

What are the system requirements for the eBook reader?

Windows XP/ Windows Vista/ Windows 7 Operating System
Compatible with 32-bit and 64-bit Operating System.
